#### **CHANGES AHEAD**

Soon we will experience a change to our worship schedule which will have a direct effect on everyone.

Starting in July, each SBLC congregation will have a Sunday on which they will NOT have a service. For us this will regularly be the 4th Sunday, so no services at Langmeil on July 28th, Aug 25, etc. Instead we will advertise alternative SBLC services you might choose to attend on that day.
