24 November at Tanunda CFS Brigade, 9 Petras Street, Tanunda Australian Red Cross offers a FREE disaster resilience education workshop statewide called the EmergencyRedi Workshop.

EmergencyRedi workshops support communities to complete a REDiPlan – an all-hazards tool developed by the Red Cross that supports communities to consider what they need to put in place to be prepared for disasters in their local context. Participants learn about the practical, psychological, and social steps they can take to prepare for emergencies and minimise the impacts of disasters and other crises on their lives.
